Campers will discover their own artistic potential through a wide range of ideas and media each day.

There are some GREAT projects planned!! Children will imagine they are exploring the ocean floor as they create faux fossils. They'll learn about textiles and book making when they experience block printing. The fascination campers discovered last year in yarn weaving will happen as they create a burlap wall hanging with beads. No art program would be complete without projects teaching ways to draw and paint. Each day several media will be used, including pastels, watercolors, pencils and acrylics. A special feature this summer will be a group quilt activity.

Lunch will be provided for campers registered for the full day. Lunch will take place from 11:30 am-12:30 pm.

STUDENT DROP-OFF and PICK-UP

Each day an adult must come inside to sign-in students under 16 years of age; for pick-up an adult must come inside to sign out the student each day.
