ACCEPTABLE WORK

We only accept high quality, hand crafted work in the traditional fine craft media of clay, wood, baskets, metal, botanicals, iron works, jewelry, paintings, glass, and fiber. Fine art objects including sculpture and two dimensional painting and photography are also accepted. The majority of the work must be produced entirely by the hands of the exhibiting artist. Exhibitors may only sell work that has been approved by the panel in regard to media type.

Food items and other consumable products are not considered art objects and therefore may not be sold. Only professional food vendors will be approved for the "food court" area of Art in the Park.

Any work which is judged to not be in compliance with the rules or standards will be be removed from display and may not be sold at the show.

STANDARDS

- The artist or craftsperson that designed the work must personally attend their booth during show hours. If the work is signed or the artist's name appears on a hang-tag, that individual is is required to be at the show. Any person or persons working in the booth must be relatively neat in appearance and clothing must adhere to the provisions in line 5 below. You are required to bring any materials needed for your booth, such as chairs, tables, displays, etc.
- A 10' x 10' "instant up" style canopy is required. Exhibitors will also be required to be prepared for inclement weather by securing their canopy to the ground with stakes through the feet of the canopy or weighted to eliminate the possibility of the canopy toppling in moderate to heavy wind. All vendor booths should be attractive from all sides and not distract from neighboring booths.
- Booths are required to be in place until at least 4:01pm the day of the show. Any exhibitor tearing down early will not be allowed to participate in any future Art in the Park events. Art in the Park is rain or shine. In the case of an emergency or hazardous weather conditions, the Art in the Park organizers will make a determination on tear down requirements at that time.
- 4. Booths, the area behind and around them are to remain clean and free of garbage.
- 5. Art in the Park is a family event. All articles must be what a reasonable person would consider in good taste with no reference to race, ethnic, gender or religious prejudice. No items that a reasonable person would consider obscene will be allowed. Art in the Park organizers will make the final judgements.
- 6. Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are prohibited.
- Vendors must park in areas designated by Art in the Park organizers. Unloading and loading will be allowed at or near your booth location during set-up and tear down hours ONLY (weather permitting). Handicap Parking will be made available, but you must have the applicable tag.
- 8. Exhibitors are responsible for collecting and reporting their own sales tax.
- Approved Food vendors will be <u>required</u> to have a trailer or 10'x10' canopy covering their food sales and prep area.
